SPITI VALLEY

Spiti Valley in winter transforms into a breathtaking white wonderland, blanketed by thick layers of snow. The temperature often drops below freezing, creating frozen rivers, icy waterfalls, and serene silence across the valley. Most routes remain closed due to heavy snowfall, making it accessible only via the Kinnaur route. The winter months offer a rare glimpse of Spiti's raw beauty, peaceful monasteries, and a chance to spot the elusive snow leopard amidst the snowy wilderness.

DAY 02 | Arrival at Chandigarh - Drive to Shimla

Welcome to the mountains!

- Upon arrival at Chandigarh, begin your scenic drive to Shimla through pine-clad hills and picturesque valleys.
- Once in Shimla, take a leisurely stroll along Mall Road, explore the colonial architecture, and soak in the crisp mountain air.

DAY 04 | Chitkul - Nako - Tabo

- Leave Chitkul and journey towards Nako, visiting the serene Nako Lake en route.
- Continue your drive through breathtaking Himalayan terrain to reach Tabo, home to the 1,000-year-old Tabo Monastery, often called the “Ajanta of the Himalayas.”

DAY 03 | Shimla - Chitkul / Sangla


- After breakfast, drive through Kufri and Narkanda along the legendary Indo-Tibetan Highway.
- Enter Kinnaur Valley through the iconic Kinnaur Gate and proceed towards Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo-China border, located on the banks of the Baspa River.

DAY 06 | Explore Hikkim, Komik & Langza (The Spiti High-Villages Loop)

- Komik: Visit the world’s highest village accessible by road.
- Langza: Capture stunning views of the giant Buddha statue and explore the fossil-rich hills.

DAY 08 | Kaza - Kalpa

DAY 05 | Tabo - Dhankar - Kaza

- After breakfast, visit the stunning Dhankar Monastery, dramatically perched on a cliff overlooking the confluence of the Spiti and Pin rivers.
- Continue the drive to Kaza, the heart of Spiti Valley – surrounded by rugged landscapes, monasteries, and charming villages.

DAY 07 | Key Monastery & Chicham Bridge

- Start the morning with a visit to Key Monastery, Spiti’s most iconic landmark and a centuries-old center of Buddhist learning.
- Later, drive to Chicham Bridge – the highest suspension bridge in Asia – and marvel at the stunning canyon views.
- Return to Kaza for a cozy evening and relaxation.


